As we reflect on our recent journey, I am pleased to note that Tata Hitachi continues to make steady progress, driven by strong execution and customer trust. We achieved machine sales of 8,909 units and crossed ₹1,230+ crore in value chain sales—reinforcing the strength of our products, services, and customer-centric approach. Additionally, achieving the milestone of 100 units in Used Equipment sales mark an important step in strengthening our lifecycle solutions portfolio.

Enhancing customer proximity and service capability remains a key focus area. The inauguration of Dealer Machine Care Facilities at Jhansi, Kolkata, Udaipur, and Lucknow is a significant move towards delivering faster, more efficient, and reliable support to our customers. Our participation in platforms such as the StoneMart Exhibition has further enabled us to showcase our offerings and deepen engagement with key stakeholders.

Encouragingly, the Excavator and Backhoe Loader markets are beginning to show signs of recovery, indicating improved demand sentiment. However, we

must remain mindful of global uncertainties. The ongoing geopolitical tensions between Israel/US and Iran may have an immediate impact on exports, while potential increases in commodity prices could influence overall cost structures. In such a dynamic environment, agility and cost discipline will be critical.

On the operational front, the commencement of production for localized versions of the ZAXIS 33U and ZAXIS 38U reflects our continued focus on localization, cost optimization, and delivering products that are well-aligned with market needs. In line with our focus on expanding our mining portfolio, the ZAXIS 890 and EX 1200V-7 are currently under trial and are planned to be introduced from July 2027 onwards, further strengthening our presence in the high-capacity segment. At the same time, we remain committed to the well-being of our people, as reflected in the inauguration of the Occupational Health Centre at our Dharwad plant—an important step towards strengthening workplace health and safety.

Moments like our Founder's Day celebrations serve as a reminder of our rich legacy, strong values, and the vision that continues to guide us forward.

As we move ahead, our focus will remain firmly on driving sustainable growth while strengthening our core capabilities. We will continue to invest in our people, enhance our product and service offerings, and deepen our engagement with customers and partners. In an evolving business environment, it is our ability to stay agile, embrace innovation, and work collaboratively that will set us apart.

I strongly believe that our collective commitment, backed by a culture of accountability and continuous improvement, will enable us to overcome challenges and seize emerging opportunities.
